

Big Labor's got a big problem.



The Employee Free Choice Act.

85% of union households believe the secret ballot is the best way to protect the individual rights of workers in union organizing elections.

72% of union households believe that binding arbitration is risky and unwise.

79% of union households believe President Obama and Congress should focus on other issues like jobs and health care before considering the Employee Free Choice Act.

65% of union households would be less likely to vote for a Member of Congress who voted to take away the secret ballot.
